  - c. SMG – Spinnaker Half Width (Mid Girth)
  - d. SFL – Spinnaker Foot Length (Symmetrical)
  - e. MHW – Mainsail Headboard Width
3. Changes to terms in Part II – Rules Section 6 (Vote needed by membership)
  - a. 6.1 – JIB (Genoa) renamed – NON-FLYING HEADSAIL (JIB/GENOA)
  - b. 6.1.1 & 6.1.2 – LP% renamed NFH% to better describe size
  - c. 6.2 – FLYING SAILS – renamed FLYING HEADSAILS
  - d. 6.2.2 – use of Symmetrical Mid Girth – as approved at 2021 AGM
