Certificate Renewals

Now that all the certificates have been updated, Handicappers can start to renew them.

Renewing is easy.

Handicappers must be registered on the PHRF-LO web site. With registration you will be given access to the "Handicappers" section which includes a menu item "Renewals".

This will present you with a list of Certificates from your club that expired in 2015.

Follow the on-line steps to renew your certificates.

CHECK YOUR RATINGS!!!

I cannot emphasize enough the importance of checking all your certificate ratings.

With the introduction of Mainsail Credits & no longer offering Backstay exemptions, I witnessed **MANY rating changes**. Some of which are quite significant.

Central Council News

Mainsails

MGT:

Central Council has voted to approve the use of the 7/8th in our formula starting as early as 2017. They are asking that we start to collect this measurement.

RFM Credit:

You will no longer see a credit for Vertical Roller Furling Mains.

Small Mainsail Credit:

Credit of up to 9 sec/nm will be applied to small mainsails.

Square Top Mains penalty adjustment:

You will no longer see a credit to correct over penalization of sails with a Head Width greater than standard.

Non-member Certificates

As of 2016 the non-member certificate fee has been reduced from \$70 to the standard certificate fee of \$35. This price level means the \$20 administration credit to the member club can no longer be provided. However, the member club that administers a non-member certificate and provides race results from their clubs will receive the \$5 credit for all certificates they administer including the non-member certificates.
